

# Kiley Family Memorial Trust Scholarships

## notes for applicants



*The Kiley Family Memorial Trust was established by John and Peter Kiley in August 2000 with the purpose of assisting students to meet their education costs in New Zealand.*

### Scholarship information

Scholarships are awarded to assist...

- secondary school students to pursue their secondary studies
- tertiary students to complete their chosen degrees.

Preference is given to students from less well off backgrounds who meet the following criteria (in order of priority)...

- wish to attend a boarding school or tertiary institution away from home
- have included agriculture in their field of study
- desire ultimately to take up a career in farming, farm management or an agriculture-based industry
- intend to enrol, or have enrolled, at preferably St Patrick's College, Silverstream or alternatively, any other Catholic boarding school
- students who live in the Taranaki/Wanganui area
- students who have an interest in the care of horses
- students who are actively involved in sport.

### Terms and conditions

1. The following are the terms and conditions applicable to applications and may be varied from time to time by Public Trust as trustee of the Kiley Family Memorial Trust.
2. Applications must be submitted on the application form which can be obtained from Public Trust's website at [www.publictrust.co.nz](http://www.publictrust.co.nz) or by writing to Public Trust at Private Bag 17-906, Greenlane, Auckland.
3. Students should refer their completed applications to their school's principal by the 20 September who will then forward the application to Public Trust no later than 30 September. Applications received after this date may be accepted at Public Trust's discretion.
4. Decisions made in relation to any scholarship are final and the trustee may seek such information regarding the applicant from the Principal of St Patrick's College Silverstream, other Catholic boarding school, or tertiary institution as deemed necessary to assist in making a decision on any application.

### Secondary scholarships

Applications for secondary scholarships must have attached...

- a reference from applicant's most recent school principal
- a letter from applicants parent/guardian

- a 250 word essay on "What you would like your occupation to be when you grow up" including "What are your favourite subjects at school and why?"

Each secondary scholarship will be for an indicative amount of either \$1,000 per annum (non-boarding students) or \$8,000 per annum (boarding students) and may be awarded over a period of five years.

### Tertiary scholarships

Applications for tertiary scholarships must have attached...

- a reference from the applicant's school Principal or Dean
- reference from applicant's current employer, if applicable
- a 250 word essay on "Why you are doing your chosen course of study?", "What is your intended career?" and "What you would like to achieve with your qualification and in your career"

Each tertiary scholarship will be for an indicative amount of \$3,000 per annum and may be awarded over a period of three years.

### Scholarship payments for future years

These are considered at the discretion of Public Trust, as trustee and subject to satisfactory performance by the applicant in the preceding year. Applicants seeking continuation of a scholarship payment should apply in writing to Public Trust at Private bag 17-906, Greenlane, Auckland, enclosing...

- for secondary scholarships
  - previous year examination results and/or reports from teachers, dean or principal
  - details of earnings.\*
- for tertiary scholarships
  - a brief review of the previous year and an outline of the course/subjects to be taken in the year ahead
  - previous year examination results
  - details of earnings.\*
